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STATE OF ILLINOIS

This compilation of state statutory citations focuses predominantly on biofuels laws in effect January 1, 1970 through December 31, 2007. In some instances, regulations have been included in the compilation due to their significance. This compilation is intended to serve as a researcher-friendly inventory of state laws by providing the formal title of relevant legislation, the standard legal citation for each statute and a brief description of the law. Some statutes and regulations listed do not specifically relate to biofuels, but are included because of their complementary relationship to the evolution of biofuels law in the state. These statutes are placed in reverse chronological order using the date of the most recent amendment to the statute. Many biofuels laws were enacted as amendments to previously passed laws.

Taxes do not apply to blends containing more than 10% biodiesel. Effective between July 1, 2003 and December 31, 2013.
Biofuels Labeling Requirement (2008)	815 ILL. COMP. STAT. 370/4.1	Both	Requirements for labeling of retail biodiesel and ethanol.
Biofuels Education and Promotion (2008)	505 ILL. COMP. STAT. 150/1	Both	The Promote Illinois Ethanol and Biodiesel Act requires certain entities to provide information about ethanol and biodiesel fuels.

Advanced Vehicle Acquisition and Biodiesel Fuel Use Requirement (2007)	30 ILL. COMP. STAT. 500/25-75	Both	Requires vehicles purchased from state funds after July 1, 2007 to be flexible fuel vehicles or hybrid electric vehicles.
State Colleges and Universities Gasohol Use Act (2007)	110 ILL. COMP. STAT. 65/5	Ethanol	Requires all gasoline vehicles owned or leased by any State college or university to be equipped to run on ethanol blends and are required to run on ethanol blends when it is available.

Biodiesel Production Tax (2003)	35 ILL. COMP. If production is over 5000 gallons/year, the producer must make motor fuel tax payments on a monthly basis.
Public Transportation - Use of Ethanol Blended Gasoline (1992)	30 ILL. COMP. STAT. 740/2-15.1	Ethanol	Beginning July 1, 1992, designated public transportation shall begin to use fuel containing ethanol blended gasoline.
State Agency Vehicle Acquisition Priorities and Biofuels Use	Executive Order 7, 2004	Both	State is working on ways to increase the use of biodiesel and ethanol in the state's vehicle fleet.
