## Biofuels Statutory Citations

### STATE OF KENTUCKY

*This compilation of state statutory citations focuses predominantly on biofuels laws in effect January 1, 1970 through December 31, 2007. In some instances, regulations have been included in the compilation due to their significance. This compilation is intended to serve as a researcher-friendly inventory of state laws by providing the formal title of relevant legislation, the standard legal citation for each statute and a brief description of the law. Some statutes and regulations listed do not specifically relate to biofuels, but are included because of their complementary relationship to the evolution of biofuels law in the state. These statutes are placed in reverse chronological order using the date of the most recent amendment to the statute. Many biofuels laws were enacted as amendments to previously passed laws.*

Alternative Fuel Producers Tax Credits (2007)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. §§ 141-422 - 141-430</a>	Both	Develop strategy to: Replace 50% light trucks and cars in state fleet with cars that run on alternative fuels. State government to increase use of ethanol and biodiesel.
Procurement strategy for greater use of alternative fuel motor vehicles; reports (2007)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. § 45A.625</a>	Both	Develop strategy to: Replace 50% light trucks and cars in state fleet with cars that run on alternative fuels. State government to increase use of ethanol and biodiesel.
Kentucky Alternative Fuel and Renewable Energy Fund Program (2007)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. §§ 154.20-400 - 154.20-420</a>	Both	Creates a fund to help Kentucky-based companies to undertake research and commercialization of alternative fuels.

Incentives for Energy Independence Act (2007)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. §§ 154.27-010 - 154.27-090</a>	Both	Provides for tax incentives for building or retrofitting alternative fuel production facilities that use biomass, along with other feedstocks. Minimum investment for biomass is \$25 million.
Gasohol Production (2006)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. §§ 247-900 - 247-920</a>	Ethanol	Promote the production of ethanol blended with gasoline.
Use of biodiesel fuel blends encouraged; reports (2002)	<a href="#">KY. REV. STAT. ANN. § 363.9055</a>	Biodiesel	Encouraging the use of blended biodiesel.
