Biofuels Statutory Citations

STATE OF NEVADA

This compilation of state statutory citations focuses predominantly on biofuels laws in effect January 1, 1970 through December 31, 2007. In some instances, regulations have been included in the compilation due to their significance. This compilation is intended to serve as a researcher-friendly inventory of state laws by providing the formal title of relevant legislation, the standard legal citation for each statute and a brief description of the law. Some statutes and regulations listed do not specifically relate to biofuels, but are included because of their complementary relationship to the evolution of biofuels law in the state. These statutes are placed in reverse chronological order using the date of the most recent amendment to the statute. Many biofuels laws were enacted as amendments to previously passed laws.

Establishment and administration of program; contents of program; designation of air pollution control agency of county for purposes of federal act; powers and duties of local air pollution control board; notice of public hearings; delegation of authority to determine violations and levy administrative penalties; cities and smaller counties; regulation of certain electric plants prohibited (2007)	NEV. REV. STAT. § 445B.500	Both	To improve air quality, a pollution control board can give money to retrofit school buses to run on biodiesel or other fuels designed to reduce amount of emissions.
"Alternative fuel" defined (2007)	NEV. REV. STAT. § 486A.030	Both	Defines alternative fuels.
Fleets: Use of Alternative Fuels (2007)	NEV. REV. STAT. §§ 486A.010 - 486A.180	Both	Starting in fiscal year 2000 and each year after, state agencies with 10 or more vehicles must purchase 90% of new vehicles that run on alternative fuels.

Issuance of general obligations by board of trustees: Authorized purposes; combining questions for voting (2003)	NEV. REV. STAT. § 387.335	Biodiesel	If board purchases vehicles to transport students, the vehicles must run on biodiesel, use to retrofit equipment to run on biodiesel, and storage equipment.
Authority of State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to develop and carry out program; education of members of general public; definitions (2001)	NEV. REV. STAT. § 486A.200	Both	Dep't of Business and Industry will develop programs to educate and provide incentives to encourage people to use alternative fuels, not those already required under statute.
"Petroleum-ethanol mixture" defined (1981)	NEV. REV. STAT. § 365.072	Ethanol	Defines petroleum-ethanol mixture as having at least 10% ethanol by volume.
