Biofuels Statutory Citations

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

This compilation of state statutory citations focuses predominantly on biofuels laws in effect January 1, 1970 through December 31, 2007. In some instances, regulations have been included in the compilation due to their significance. This compilation is intended to serve as a researcher-friendly inventory of state laws by providing the formal title of relevant legislation, the standard legal citation for each statute and a brief description of the law. Some statutes and regulations listed do not specifically relate to biofuels, but are included because of their complementary relationship to the evolution of biofuels law in the state. These statutes are placed in reverse chronological order using the date of the most recent amendment to the statute. Many biofuels laws were enacted as amendments to previously passed laws.

Motor Fuel Inventory Fund (2009)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 228:24-a	Biodiesel	Effective Jan. 1, 2009, Commissioner is to purchase diesel that contains at least 5% biodiesel. But the commissioner is encouraged to purchase diesel containing at least 20% biodiesel.
Biodiesel (2009)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 259:6-a	Biodiesel	Defines biodiesel.
Biodiesel Distributor License (2009)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 260:36-d	Biodiesel	A person who refines, distills, prepares, blends, manufactures, or purchases biodiesel is required to get a license with the state. A user of biodiesel or blended biodiesel, and it is used in equipment other than vehicles used on public roads, is entitled to a refund of the toll paid, if it has been paid.

Additional Recordkeeping Requirements for Biodiesel Distributors (2009)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 260:43-b	Biodiesel	Biodiesel distributors shall keep records for 4 years to demonstrate biodiesel sold meets required standards.
Biodiesel Not Meeting ASTM Fuel Quality Standards Not to be Sold in the State. (2009)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 260:52-f	Biodiesel	All biodiesel sold must meet ASTM standards.
Determination and Payment of Road Toll. (2008)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 260:38	Ethanol	Ethanol manufacturers, manufacturing in the state, are required to get a license with the state.
Division of Plant and Property Management (2008)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 21-I:11	Biodiesel	Requiring state to purchase heating oil containing at least 5% biodiesel. The Dep't of Transportation is to purchase blended biodiesel.
Definitions (2007)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 362-A:1-a	Biodiesel	Defines biodiesel.
Definitions (2007)	N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 362-F:2	Biodiesel	Defines biodiesel in the "biomass fuels" for the Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard.
