## Biofuels Statutory Citations

### STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA

*This compilation of state statutory citations focuses predominantly on biofuels laws in effect January 1, 1970 through December 31, 2007. In some instances, regulations have been included in the compilation due to their significance. This compilation is intended to serve as a researcher-friendly inventory of state laws by providing the formal title of relevant legislation, the standard legal citation for each statute and a brief description of the law. Some statutes and regulations listed do not specifically relate to biofuels, but are included because of their complementary relationship to the evolution of biofuels law in the state. These statutes are placed in reverse chronological order using the date of the most recent amendment to the statute. Many biofuels laws were enacted as amendments to previously passed laws.*

Biodiesel Content in Diesel Fuel Sold for on-road use (2008)	<a href="#">73 PA. CONS. STAT. ANN. § 1650.3</a>	Biodiesel	All diesel fuel sold or offered for sale to ultimate consumers in this Commonwealth for use in on-road compression ignition engines must contain certain percentages of biodiesel.
Biomass-based diesel production incentives (2008)	<a href="#">73 PA. CONS. STAT. ANN. § 1647.3.1</a>	Biodiesel	Production incentive of 75¢ per gallon for biomass-based diesel produced and sold in this Commonwealth for commercial transportation purposes or for residential heating.
Cellulosic ethanol content in gasoline (2008)	<a href="#">73 PA. CONS. STAT. ANN. § 1650.4</a>	Ethanol	All gasoline sold or offered for sale to ultimate consumers in this Commonwealth must contain at least 10% cellulosic ethanol by volume

Definitions (2008)	<a href="#">73 PA. CONS. STAT. ANN. § 1647.2</a>	Ethanol	Defines ethanol and alternative fuels
Alternative Fuels Tax (1997)	<a href="#">75 Pa. Cons. Stat. Ann. § 9004</a>	Both	A tax is imposed on alternative fuels used to propel vehicles of any kind on public highways. The rate of tax is determined on a gasoline gallon equivalent basis.
