MA Gen. Laws ch. 184, § 1

*Current through laws passed by the Regular Session of the 2025 Massachusetts State Legislature.

MA Gen. Laws ch. 184, § 1. Rights of aliens.

Aliens may take, hold, transmit and convey real property, and no title to real property shall be invalid on account of the alienage of a former owner.
